Time Frame	Senate	House	Opportunity to Amend
May 21-25, June 4-8	Senate Floor Debate		6-12 amendments per "side" allowed
June 7 or 8	Senate vote on final passage		Vote YAY or NAY 60 votes required
First part of June		House Immigration Subcommittee markup	Lots of amendments, don't know what bill will be starting point
Second part of June		House Judiciary Committee markup	More amendments
Sometime in July		Judiciary Bill goes to Rules Committee	Rules Committee decides which and how many amendments will be allowed on House floor
Sometime in mid to late July		House floor debate on amendments	Only what is allowed by Rules Committee
Late July		House floor—vote on final passage	Vote YAY OR NAY, simple majority required (218 votes)
During and after August recess	Senate	House	Conference Committee deliberations, horsetrading, amendments, etc.;
August-Sept.	Senate	House	Conference "report" goes to Senate and House floors for final vote, YAY OR NAY
Sept-Oct-Nov?			Final Bill Presented to President for signature
