 3 **OR POSSESSION OF FIREARMS BY, ALIENS**
 4 **NOT LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT**
 5 **RESIDENCE.**

6 Section 922 of title 18, United States Code, is
 7 amended—

8 (1) in subsection (d)(5)(B), by striking “(y)(2)”
 9 and all that follows and inserting “(y), is in the
 10 United States not as an alien lawfully admitted for
 11 permanent residence;”;

1 (2) in subsection (g)(5)(B), by striking “(y)(2)”
2 and all that follows and inserting “(y), is in the
3 United States not as an alien lawfully admitted for
4 permanent residence;”; and

5 (3) in subsection (y)—

6 (A) in the heading by striking “ADMITTED
7 UNDER NONIMMIGRANT VISAS” and inserting
8 “NOT LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT
9 RESIDENCE”;

10 (B) in paragraph (1), by amending sub-
11 paragraph (B) to read as follows:

12 “(B) the term ‘lawfully admitted for permanent
13 residence’ has the same meaning as in section
14 101(a)(20) of the Immigration and Nationality Act
15 (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(20)).”;

16 (C) in paragraph (2), by striking “under a
17 nonimmigrant visa” and inserting “but not law-
18 fully admitted for permanent residence”; and

19 (D) in paragraph (3)(A), by striking “ad-
20 mitted to the United States under a non-
21 immigrant visa” and inserting “lawfully admit-
22 ted to the United States but not as an alien
23 lawfully admitted for permanent residence”.
