Viz:

1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:

2 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . RIGHT TO REVIEW CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN RE-**  
3 **MOVAL PROCEEDINGS.**

4 Section 240(b) (8 U.S.C. 1229a(b)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (4)—

6 (A) by redesignating subparagraphs (B)

7 and (C) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respec-

8 tively; and

9 (B) by inserting after subparagraph (A)

10 the following new subparagraph:

1           “(B) the alien shall, at the beginning of  
2 the proceedings or at a reasonable time there-  
3 after, automatically receive a complete copy of  
4 all relevant documents in the possession of the  
5 Department of Homeland Security, including all  
6 documents (other than documents protected  
7 from disclosure by privilege, including national  
8 security information referenced in subparagraph  
9 (C), law enforcement sensitive information, and  
10 information prohibited from disclosure pursuant  
11 to any other provision of law ) contained in the  
12 file maintained by the Government that in-  
13 cludes information with respect to all trans-  
14 actions involving the alien during the immigra-  
15 tion process (commonly referred to as an ‘A-  
16 file’), and all documents pertaining to the alien  
17 that the Department of Homeland Security has  
18 obtained or received from other government  
19 agencies, unless the alien waives the right to re-  
20 ceive such documents by executing a knowing  
21 and voluntary waiver in a language that he or  
22 she understands fluently,”; and  
23           (2) by adding at the end the following new  
24 paragraph:

1           “(8) FAILURE TO PROVIDE ALIEN REQUIRED  
2           DOCUMENTS.—In the absence of a waiver under sub-  
3           paragraph (B) of paragraph (4), a removal pro-  
4           ceeding may not proceed until the alien has received  
5           the documents as required under such subpara-  
6           graph.”.
