4 (b) DUAL INTENT.—Section 214(h) (8 U.S.C.  
5 1184(h)) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(h) DUAL INTENT.—The fact that an alien is, or  
7 intends to be, the beneficiary of an application for a pref-  
8 erence status filed under section 204, seeks a change or  
9 adjustment of status after completing a legitimate period  
10 of nonimmigrant stay, or has otherwise sought permanent  
11 residence in the United States shall not constitute evi-

1 dence of intent to abandon a foreign residence that would  
2 preclude the alien from obtaining or maintaining—

3           “(1) a visa or admission as a nonimmigrant de-  
4 scribed in subparagraph (E), (F)(i), (F)(ii),  
5 (H)(i)(b), (H)(i)(c), (L), (O), (P), (V), or (W) of  
6 section 101(a)(15); or

7           “(2) the status of a nonimmigrant described in  
8 any such subparagraph.”.
