Reason for Change: U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is in the process of automating Form I-94 Arrival/Departure Records to streamline passenger processing. CBP enters data admission information into the Treasury Enforcement Communications System (TECS) and the Arrival and Departure Information System (ADIS). Form I-94 admission information is used by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to search TECS and ADIS to verify applicant, petitioner or beneficiary status in the United States at the time an application or petition is filed. Additional data fields, related to passport or travel document information captured by CBP at the port of entry, are being incorporated for USCIS to search TECS and ADIS and to verify status in the United States.
