(a) No funds, resources or fees made available to the Secretary of Homeland Security, or to any 2 3 other official of a Federal agency, by this Act or any other Act for any fiscal year, including any deposits into the 4 5 "Immigration Examinations Fee Account" established 6 under section 286(m) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 USC 1356(m)), may be used to consider or adju-7 dicate any new, renewal or previously denied application 8 for any alien requesting consideration of deferred action 9 for childhood arrivals, as authorized by the Executive 10 memorandum dated June 15, 2012, and effective on Au-11 12 gust 15, 2012 (or any substantially similar policy changes issued or taken on or after January 9, 2015, whether set 13 forth in memorandum, Executive order, regulation, direc-14 tive, or by other action). 15

(b) The budgetary effects of this section shall not be
entered on either PAYGO scorecard maintained pursuant
to section 4(d) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of
2010.
