



## A Access eRegistry, and DHS Portal



#### **eRegistry**

One-time registration in eRegistry is required to access DHS Portal.

DHS ICE personnel no longer need to register to use DHS Portal due to a federation agreement between EOIR and DHS ICE.



#### **DHS Portal**

DHS can use DHS Portal to:

- File a Notice To Appear (NTA)
- View case details
- Electronically file case related documents
- View and print electronic case records (eROP records)
- Find out whether documents have been accepted or rejected by EOIR, with rejection explanation



#### **eROP**

## (Electronic Record of Proceedings)

Electronic repository of official case records.

Note: Existing paper-based ROPs will remain in hardcopy files.
