ECAS Makes Accessing Information Easier

When you need to	Before ECAS	With ECAS
Submit case records and forms (examples: EOIR 33 Change of Address, evidence, Notice to Appear (NTA), etc.)	Travel to court and submit NTA in person, or spend \$\$ to mail it	Electronically file through ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office
Find out case details (status, hearing date, decisions, assigned judges, etc.)	Call or travel to court and request at the court window	View in ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office
View and get copies of ROP case documents	Submit written request via mail or in person, or make an appointment to view ROP at the court	View/download eROP* documents in ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office
Receive notification of added case documents, hearings, orders and decisions	Wait to receive notifications and documents by mail	Receive notifications and documents via email as soon as they are approved or completed
DHS or Respondent's Attorney or Accredited Representative		Replaces Paper ROP eROP ectronic Record f Proceedings) Immigration Judge
