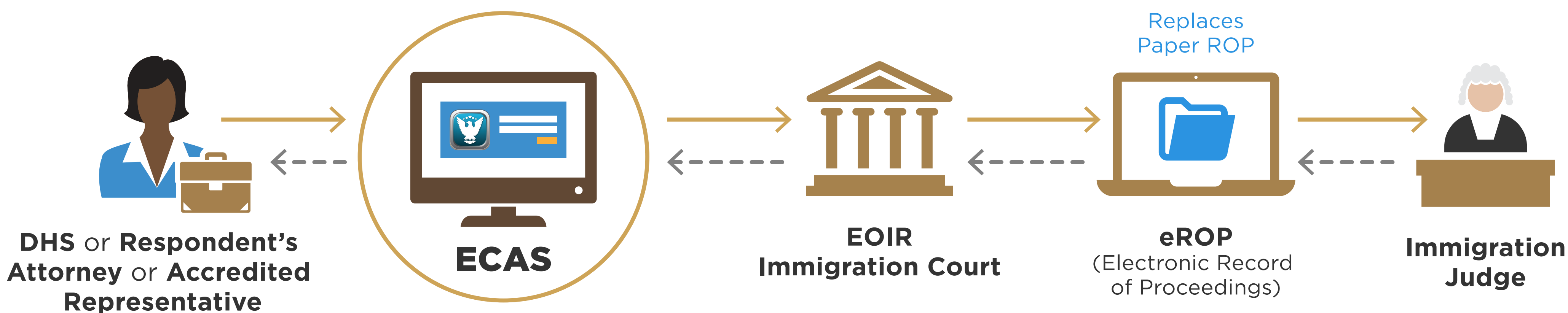
ECAS Makes *Accessing Information Easier*

When you need to...

Before ECAS

With ECAS

<p>1 Submit case records and forms (examples: EOIR 33 Change of Address, evidence, Notice to Appear (NTA), etc.)</p>	<p>Travel to court and submit NTA in person, or spend \$\$ to mail it</p>	<p>Electronically file through ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office ✓</p>
<p>2 Find out case details (status, hearing date, decisions, assigned judges, etc.)</p>	<p>Call or travel to court and request at the court window</p>	<p>View in ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office ✓</p>
<p>3 View and get copies of ROP case documents</p>	<p>Submit written request via mail or in person, or make an appointment to view ROP at the court</p>	<p>View/download eROP* documents in ECAS, 24/7, without leaving your office ✓</p>
<p>4 Receive notification of added case documents, hearings, orders and decisions</p>	<p>Wait to receive notifications and documents by mail</p>	<p>Receive notifications and documents via email as soon as they are approved or completed ✓</p>
