DHS Ends Form I-9 Requirement Flexibility

COVID-19 <u>temporary flexibilities</u> for Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, <u>will end on July 31, 2023</u>. U. S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) recently announced that employers must complete in-person physical document inspections for employees whose documents were inspected remotely during the temporary flexibilities by August 30, 2023.

This new announcement gives employers additional time to complete in-person physical inspection of identity and employment authorization documents, and <u>annotate the Form I-9</u> for this population. These flexibilities were initially announced in March 2020 and updated in March 2021. <u>See I-9 Central Questions and Answers for more information</u>.

DHS published a <u>Notice of Proposed Rulemaking</u> for alternative procedures allowing remote document examination for Form I-9 last year. DHS anticipates publishing a Final Rule in the Federal Register that will implement this proposal.
