USCIS Case Processing Times uscis.gov/processingtimes

- 2018—shifted to new methodology
- Uses completion data instead of pending inventory
- Started with four forms, now have 16 forms
- Posted range is from 50th to 93rd percentile

using new methodology



- Our self-service tools are among the most popular in government






USCIS Digital Tools (FY20 Data)






Eleven Forms Available Online

- 1. Form I-90, Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card
- 2. Form N-400, Application for Naturalization
- 3. Form N-336, Request for a Hearing on a Decision in Naturalization Proceedings (Under S. 336 of INA)
- 4. Form N-565, Application for Replacement of Naturalization/Citizenship Document
- 5. Form N-600, Application for Certificate of Citizenship
- 6. Form N-600K, Application for Citizenship and Issuance of Certificate
- 7. Form I-539, Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status (filed by certain nonimmigrant academic and vocational students)
- 8. Form I-130, Petition for Eligible Relative
- 9. Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization (students only) (testing stage now)
- 10. Form G-639, Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act Request
- 11. Form AR-11, Change of Address Card *** (USCIS online account not needed)

Sign Up

Your USCIS account is only for you. Do not create a shared account with family or friends. Individual accounts allow us to best serve you and protect your personal information.

You must provide your email address below if you are the one who is filing a form online, submitting an online request, or tracking a case.

Sign up for an account at <u>myaccount.uscis.gov</u> to get case alerts via email or text message

Changing Your Address with USCIS

- 1. USCIS Online Account—<u>myaccount.uscis.gov</u>
 - For people who applied online or added a paper-filed form with IOE receipt number to their online account
 - Also, must complete Change of Address, preferably at <u>egov.uscis.gov/coa</u>
- 2. Change of Address Online—<u>egov.uscis.gov/coa</u>
 - For anyone who has a non-IOE receipt numbers
 - Receipt number and email address required

Note: Anyone who applied for an immigration benefit based on being the victim of domestic violence, trafficking, or other crime must update their address by mailing us a paper Form AR-11. See <u>uscis.gov/addresschange</u> for the correct mailing addresses.

Online Tools—What to Expect

- Clear navigation
- Privacy and security
- Some tools answer immediately (case status, processing times, Emma)
- E-request & web form inquiries take about 15 days





Inquiries—When and How to Follow-Up?

When to follow-up?

If our response:

- Does not answer the question asked
- Is unclear or confusing
- Or if you did not get a response

How to follow-up?

- 1. Send secure message thru USCIS online account
- 2. Submit inquiry using e-request
- 3. Call our contact center





Online Filing vs. eProcessing

Online Filing

- Applicant submits form through USCIS online account
- We process case electronically, even paper submissions



eProcessing

- Massive effort to modernize processes, improve efficiency
- Reduce time, cost, and effort spent working with paper files
- One piece of eProcessing

USCIS Online Account Features (for IOE & MCT receipt numbers)

All notices, correspondence are posted to customer's account

- Receipt, interview, oath ceremony & biometrics notices
- Request for Evidence (RFE)
- PDF snapshot of completed form
- Account acceptance notices (for eligible paper cases)




Applicants cannot self-schedule appointments

If	Then
USCIS cancels appointment or closes an office	USCIS automatically reschedules appointment. Applicant does not need to do anything.
Applicant misses appointment or wants new appointment	Applicant must follow instructions on appointment notice to reschedule. USCIS will not reschedule until applicant notifies USCIS.*

Current Challenges to Online Form Development


- Last year the Agency experienced a reduction in contract support due to the financial situation.
