- 3 (a) Resettlement Support Authorized.—Not
- 4 withstanding any other provision of law, an Afghan en-
- 5 trant is eligible for any form of resettlement assistance,
- 6 entitlement program, or other benefit (including services
- 7 for unaccompanied refugee minors) that is available to a
- 8 refugee (as such term is defined in section 207 of the Im-
- 9 migration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1157) under
- 10 Federal law to the same extent, and for the same period
- 11 of time as any such assistance, program, or benefit is
- 12 available to a refugee.
- 13 (b) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term "Afghan en-
- 14 trant" means a national of Afghanistan (or in the case
- 15 of an alien having no nationality, a person who last habit-
- 16 ually resided in Afghanistan) who was initially paroled
- 17 into the United States pursuant to section 212(d)(5) of
- 18 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182) dur-
- 19 ing the period beginning on July 1, 2021 and ending on
- 20 July 1, 2025.
- 21 (c) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
