<p>Page 1  <b>Who May Use This Form?</b></p>	<p>This form is used only by attorneys and accredited representatives (as defined in 8 CFR 1.1(f) and 292.1(a)(4).</p> <p>Attorneys admitted to the practice of law in countries other than the United States must use Form G-28I and may only represent individuals in matters filed in DHS offices outside the geographical confines of the United States.</p> <p>An attorney or accredited representative who seeks to withdraw his or her appearance in a proceeding before DHS must file a written request with the DHS office with jurisdiction over the pending matter. An attorney or accredited representative who seeks to be recognized by DHS as the new representative for an applicant, petitioner, or respondent must file a properly completed Form G-28 with the DHS office with jurisdiction over the pending matter. An attorney or accredited representative who is appearing for a limited purpose at the request of the attorney or accredited representative of record must file a properly completed Form G-28 as noted on the form.</p> <p>When a person acts in a representative capacity, his or her personal appearance or signature shall constitute a representation under the provisions of 8 CFR 103.2(a)(3) and 292.1(a)(1) or 292.1(a)(4) that he or she is</p>	<p>This form is used only by attorneys and accredited representatives (as defined in 8 CFR 1.1(f) and 292.1(a)(4).</p> <p>An attorney or accredited representative, who is appearing for a limited purpose at the request of the attorney or accredited representative who has previously filed a Form G-28 in the case, must complete <b>Part 2C</b> and <b>Part 2A</b> or <b>2B</b>.</p> <p>A law student or law graduate who is working under the direct supervision of an attorney or accredited representative, pursuant to 8 CFR 292.1(a)(2), must complete <b>Part 2D</b> on the same Form G-28 filed by the supervising attorney or accredited representative. The law student or law graduate must sign the Form G-28 in <b>Part 3</b>, next to the signature of the supervising attorney or accredited representative. A law student or law graduate may be required to verify that he or she is eligible as required in 8 CFR 292.1(a)(2). The appearance of a law student or law graduate is not automatic and requires the permission of the DHS official before whom he or she wishes to appear. They will be required to provide the information listed in the regulations to the DHS official before whom he or she wishes to appear.</p> <p>When a person acts in a representative capacity, his or her personal appearance or signature will constitute a representation under the provisions of 8 CFR 103.2(a)(3) and 292.1(a)(1) or 292.1(a)(4) that he or she is authorized and qualified to represent the individual. Further proof of authority to act in a representative capacity may be required.</p>
