no one in Puerto Rico can keep an original birth certificate since it's illegal to keep someone else's certified copy. You can be asked to show your birth certificate so it can be copied or information taken from it but the new birth certificate issued after July 1, 2010 should be held by the citizen for life, not filed away in a school or other place where it can be stolen to steal the identity of an American citizen born in Puerto Rico".
